On Friday, August 10, 2012 at approximately 10:34 PM the Crook County Sheriff's Office received a report of an overdue motorist/ missing person from the Bend Police Department. The initial information received indicated that Michelle Langdon age 34 of Harrisburg, Oregon was en-route from Bend to the area of Little Summit Prairie in the Ochoco National Forest to go camping. Michelle was traveling with two children ages 4 and 6.

At approximately 3:00 PM family received a text message from Michelle indicating she was lost. Family then made the missing persons report to the Bend Police Department, at which point the investigation was forwarded on to the Crook County Sheriff's Office.

Crook County Sheriff's Office Search and Rescue was activated, and searchers responded to the area covering routes that lead to the Little Summit Prairie area.

On August 11, 2012 at approximately 8:26 AM Crook County Search and Rescue was informed that Michelle and the children had arrived at the camp at Little Summit Prairie late the night prior. Michelle and the children were reported to be in good condition.
