Medical Assistance: Emergency personnel will be available, but familial support will be required based on the individual participant's special needs.

Liability: Provided by various partners.

Food: A barbecue lunch, prepared by the Kiwanis Club of Prineville will be ready for hungry anglers following the fishing activities. Everyone attending is invited to enjoy the meal at no charge.

Weather: In the case of inclement weather the event will be cancelled.

Other: As part of the event, participants will receive the following: C.A.S.T. T-shirt and hat; fishing rod and reel; a picture and plaque; and lots of other fun goodies.
