- Liability:** Provided by various partners.
- Food:** A barbecue lunch, prepared by the Kiwanis Club of Prineville will be ready for hungry anglers following the fishing activities. Everyone attending is invited to enjoy the meal at no charge.
- Weather:** In the case of inclement weather the event will be cancelled.
- Other:** As part of the event, participants will receive the following: C.A.S.T. T-shirt and hat; fishing rod and reel; a picture and plaque; and lots of other fun goodies.
