On March 22, 2010, 5:06pm, Crook County Sheriff's Office received a report regarding a stranded lost motorist, Darwin Siebert, of Crooked River Ranch. Mr. Siebert believed himself to be approximately 25 to 30 miles S SW of Ashwood, OR.

Crook County Sheriff's Search and Rescue was activated and did a road search of the area that Mr. Siebert was believed to be. They found no tracks that led them to believe he was in the area. The search was then turned over to Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. Jefferson County Search and Rescue started a search Tuesday morning and called in an OSP plane to assist with the search. The OSP plane spotted the stranded subject on the 2720 road at the intersection of the 2740 in Crook County.

Jefferson County Search and Rescue and Crook County Search and Rescue were enroute to retrieve Mr. Siebert. When Jefferson County Search and Rescue located Mr. Siebert he was in good health and said that he thought he was taking a short cut when he became stuck in the snow. Mr. Siebert was given a ride by Forest Service Law Enforcement to Terrebonne where he was picked up by his wife.
